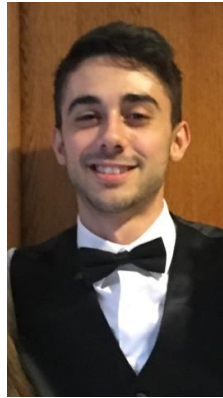


**Our Musicians: Renee Long, violin &

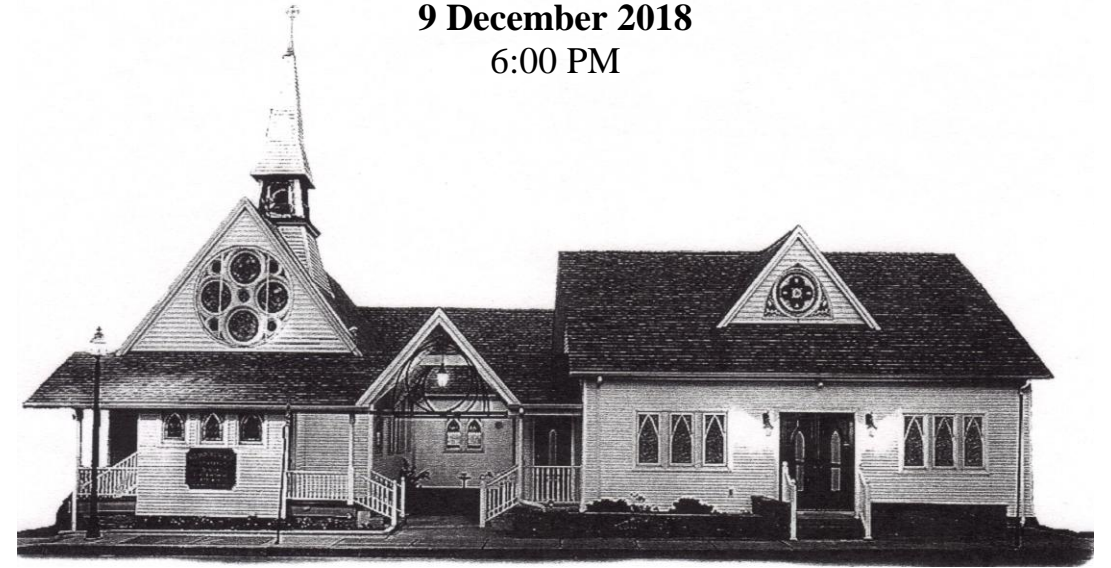
